DESIGN INSPIRATION

The Scalamandré Zebras Quatrefoil Planter is for all of us design adventurers. Featuring the iconic Scalamandré pattern, "Zebras" in denim, the porcelain centerpiece planter is perfectly shaped for a variety of uses ranging from an actual flowerpot, able to hold four 6" diameter plants, to a tabletop beverage tub for entertaining. A little history on the Scalamandré Zebras design: Originally designed in the 1940's for the Gino of Capri restaurant, lovingly known as "Ginos" by New Yorkers, Scalamandré restored the Zebras wallcovering in the upper east side institution in the 1970's after it was destroyed in a fire. Flora Scalamandré, wife of Franco, free handed the signature motif that would come to be known as the iconic Scalamandré Zebras. The pattern is celebrated throughout the world and has been featured in films such as the "Royal Tenenbaums" and "Mighty Aphrodite." The pattern design has grown in color offerings and mediums. Measurements: 8" Height x 14" Diameter. The Zebra Blue Quatrefoil Planter can coordinate with the Zebra Blue Garden Seat.
